

Topic—Meet the Flintstones

English

- Core text—Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura.
- Non-Chronological reports and recounting a story.
- Writing a character description.
- SPAG — adding suffixes, Creating negative meaning using a prefix, words with 'k' spelt 'ch'. Extending sentences with more than one clause by using a wider range of conjunctions, including when, if because, although.

Mathematics

Multiplication and division: multiply and divide 2 digit numbers by a 1 digit number

Length and perimeter: measure in m, cm and mm; equivalent lengths; comparing lengths and adding lengths.

Fractions: denominators of unit fractions and non-unit fractions; comparing and ordering fractions; understanding the whole; compare and order non-unit fractions;

Science

Light and Shadows

Children will learn about how we see objects, the ways in which different objects reflect different amounts of light and how these ideas can be applied to staying safe at night. They will explore what causes a shadow, as well as how the shape and size of a shadow can be affected by its position. They will learn how exposure to sunlight can cause harm, and about ways by which they can protect themselves. The children will carry out some investigations to test materials such as sunglasses and materials to reduce/block out light, and develop their skills with respect to the working scientifically strand of the curriculum.

RE

Sacrament of Reconciliation:

The Great Commandment—to understand what it means to make a wrong choice and reflect on how this affects us and others;

- Art & Design—Palaeolithic and Neolithic art.
- Music: Progression—playing the recorder.
- PSICHE and RSE: Children will focus on a 'Created to Love Others' module. They will learn strategies for developing healthy relationships and keeping safe both online and in our daily lives.
- PE—Gymnastics: Travelling with a change of direction, stretching and curling

Espresso Coding—Learn Coding Skills; sequence and animation; conditional events and debugging.


