

## Core Subjects

### English

This half term, Year 4 students will be:

- Continuing to develop their reading, writing and verbal skills
- Participating in storytelling and performance poetry to express themselves
- Broadening their vocabulary and building up their confidence, fluency and expression when reading aloud
- Applying an increasing range of reading strategies to read, comprehend and respond to fiction and non-fiction texts
- Developing their writing and language
- Listening to, discussing and writing a range of poems, stories and non-fiction
- Grammar: Adverbs, tense, conjunctions.

### Mathematics

Multiplication and division:

- Multiply and divide by 10/100.
- Related facts—multiplication and division.
- Informal and formal methods for multiplication.
- Multiply a 2/3 digit number by a 1 digit number.
- Use efficient methods; solve worded problems.

Measurement: length and perimeter

- Measure in km/m; equivalent lengths.
- Find and calculate the perimeter of rectangular shapes and regular polygons.

### RE

Jesus, the Teacher

- Know about the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple and His baptism and reflect on what His baptism means for us
- Learn about Jesus' disciples and be aware that we are also called to follow Jesus
- Think about the Good News that Jesus teaches
- Know some of the Parables Jesus taught and reflect on their meaning.

### Science

Sound

- Identify how sounds are made, associating them with vibrations
- Recognise that vibrations travel through a medium to the ear.
- Find patterns between the pitch and volume of a sound.

Working scientifically:

- Set up comparative and fair tests and report on findings.

### Computing

- Developing their research, word processing, and collaborative working skills whilst learning how web pages and web sites are created, exploring how to change layouts, embed images and videos and link between pages. Use the internet safely to research information.
