Revelation: The Gospel accounts of key events in the life of Jesus: nativity, passion, death, resurrection, ascension. *A gift from God- the resurrection of Jesus.*

Revelation: Gospel accounts of how the lives of men and women were changed by their encounters with Jesus. *Jesus appears to Mary of Magdala & the Apostles.*

Revelation: Gospel accounts of the coming of the Holy Spirit and transformation of the disciples. *Pentecost.*

The Church: Ways of taking part in the life of the Church. *Jesus is with us, Importance of prayer*

Celebration: Church's celebrations of significant events in the life of Jesus. *Resurrection of Jesus.*

Celebration: Community prayer. *The Our Father; The Rosary.*

Celebration: Prayer in the life of Jesus. *Importance of prayer; Parable of the Pharisee & Tax Collector; Jesus teaching the 'Our Father'.*

Celebration: A variety of prayers and prayer forms, formal and informal used for personal and community prayer. *Types of prayer: thanksgiving, praise, sorrow, petition, meditation, contemplation; The Rosary*

Life in Christ: The suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus as a sign of love, sacrifice and the source of new life. *Jesus rose from the dead and appeared to Mary of Magdala.*

Revelation: Gospel accounts of how the lives of men and women were changed by their encounters with Jesus. *How the Apostles changed when they received the Holy Spirit*

Revelation: Gospel accounts of the coming of the Holy Spirit and transformation of the disciples. *Transformation of the disciples.*

The Church: God's call to individuals and their different responses. *The Apostles.*

The Church: The gifts of the Holy Spirit which are given to individuals and groups for the service of the whole community. *Results of transformation; new people brought into the Church; miraculous signs.*

The Church: The cost of discipleship. *The Early Christian Community, The persecution of the apostles.*

The Church: Teaching role of the apostles (e.g.) through New Testament letters. *New people brought into the Church, miracles worked by Peter & Paul, Peter & Paul preaching about Jesus.*

Celebration: Church's celebrations of significant events in the life of Jesus. *The Ascension, Pentecost.*

Other Religions: Children will have a visit from a Greek Orthodox Priest to talk about Greek Easter.
