### Computing: Data Handling

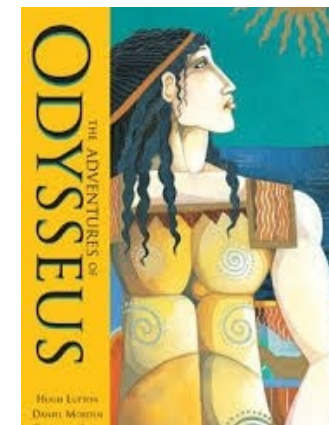
