At the weekend, pilgrims from our Parish went on a Diocesan pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham.



Our Lady of Walsingham is a special name for Mary, the mother of Jesus, connected to a vision Mary had with a local lady named Richeldis in the year 1061. Mary asked Richeldis to build a special house like the one where the Angel Gabriel first visited her. This Holy House became a special place for people to pray. Pilgrims visit Walsingham and remember the mystery of the Annunciation and Mary's 'Yes' to being the mother of Jesus.
