The month of remembrance ends with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe—the final Sunday of the Church’s liturgical year. This feast reminds us that Christ is Lord of all creation and that His kingdom is one of truth, justice, peace, and love. For schools, Christ the King offers a chance to celebrate Jesus’ reign not as one of worldly power, but of service and self-giving love. It also links beautifully with the mission of Catholic education, as pupils are invited to build Christ’s kingdom in their daily lives.
