St Andrew Dung-Lac



- St Andrew Dũng-Lạc was **born in Vietnam** in 1795.
- He grew up in a **poor family**. He learned about Jesus and chose to follow Him.
- Andrew became a **kind and caring priest** who helped the poor and taught people about God.
- It was **dangerous to be a Christian** at that time, but Andrew stayed brave and faithful.
- He is remembered as one of the **Vietnamese Martyrs** who showed great courage.
- His **feast day is 24th November**.
- **St Andrew Dũng-Lạc reminds us to be brave, kind, and faithful.**
