Year 6 Curriculum Overview: Summer 1 2026

RE: To the ends of the Earth

In this branch, pupils will explore St John's account of the Resurrection and how it shows the restoration of humanity's relationship with God. Pupils will make connections between Genesis and the Resurrection, recognising Jesus as the 'last Adam' who brings new life, and exploring the symbolism of the garden, light and darkness, and Jesus' encounter with Mary Magdalene.
