

## Scripture references to accompany each mystery in the Rosary

### The Joyful Mysteries

**1<sup>st</sup> Joyful Mystery (Staff)** - The Annunciation - Luke 1: 26-38

**2<sup>nd</sup> Joyful Mystery (6A)** - The Visitation - Luke 1: 39-56

**3<sup>rd</sup> Joyful Mystery (6S)** - The Birth of Jesus - Luke 2: 1-20 or Matthew 2: 1-16

**4<sup>th</sup> Joyful Mystery (6M)** - The Presentation of Jesus in the temple - Luke 2: 22-40

**5<sup>th</sup> Joyful Mystery (5G)** - Finding Jesus in the temple - Luke 2: 41-52

### The Sorrowful Mysteries

**1<sup>st</sup> Sorrowful Mystery (5C)** - The Agony in the Garden - Matthew 26: 36-57

**2<sup>nd</sup> Sorrowful Mystery (5OS)** - The Scouring at the Pillar - Mark 15: 15

**3<sup>rd</sup> Sorrowful Mystery (4M)** - Crowning with Thorns - Mark 15:16 or Matthew 27:28-30 or John 19: 4-5

**4<sup>th</sup> Sorrowful Mystery (4W)** - Carrying of the Cross - Luke 23: 27-32 or Mark 15: 20-21 Or John 19:17

**5<sup>th</sup> Sorrowful Mystery (4K- Miss Falzone)** - The Crucifixion - Matthew 27: 33-51 or Mark 15: 28-35 or Luke 23: 32-46 or John 19:19-30

### The Glorious Mysteries

**1<sup>st</sup> Glorious Mystery (3M)** - The Resurrection - Matthew 27:60-28:9 or Mark 6: 2-11 or Luke 23: 54-56 or John 19: 40-20:18

**2<sup>nd</sup> Glorious Mystery (3OT)** - The Ascension - Acts 1: 6-11

**3<sup>rd</sup> Glorious Mystery (3BC)** - The Coming of the Holy Spirit - Acts 1: 12-14 and Acts 2: 1-8

**4<sup>th</sup> Glorious Mystery (RW)** - The Assumption of Our Lady - Luke 1: 46-50

**5<sup>th</sup> Glorious Mystery (RS)** - Mary is crowned Queen of Heaven - The Coronation of Mary is not recounted in scripture, but is deeply rooted in scripture and Revelation 12:1 would be an appropriate reference to use)

## **The Mysteries of Light**

**1<sup>st</sup> Luminous Mystery (RB)** - The Baptism in the Jordan - (2 Corinthians 5:21 or Matthew 3: 17)

**2<sup>nd</sup> Luminous Mystery (2NS)** - The Wedding at Cana (John 2: 1-12)
