We are imposing these measures to reduce the chances of children coming into contact with the virus to an absolute minimum. We will inform you of revised dates as soon as possible, where applicable. As a school, we continue to put the safety of the children at the forefront of all we do and follow the advice of Public Health England.

As present, there are no plans to close the school. Should the need arise, however, parents will receive notification by text and a message will also be relayed through the school website at the earliest possible opportunity. Work will be uploaded to the learning platform (DB primary) so children will be able to continue in their learning. Year 6 will also be given additional paper-based SATs revision for maths.

I hope the measures that we are putting in place will prove reassuring to parents and that the chances of the children coming into contact with the virus are kept to an absolute minimum.
