# **Catering Challenge**

I thought I would include this message that I received from our caterers yesterday. It may giver you an insight into the challenges that the sector is facing at the moment, but with an encouraging and reassuring sentiment.

Many of you may have read the worrying headlines in the national press in the last 48hrs such as "Now schools could be forced to cut meal portions or use cheaper ingredients: Leading wholesaler warns canteens face 'difficult decisions' amid soaring food inflation". Whilst the sector is experiencing unprecedented challenges in the supply chain in terms of both cost and product, I can categorically confirm Enfield Catering will not cut meal portions, nor will we ever compromise on the quality we serve our children.

I ask for your support as we all continue to navigate this crisis in the UK, my team and I are all committed to being fully transparent in our approach. If we are forced to make a menu change, we will always consult you and explain why. The change will never been to reduce a portion size or provide less quality.
