*The weather is lovely at the moment - walk at least some or all of the way to school whenever you can.*

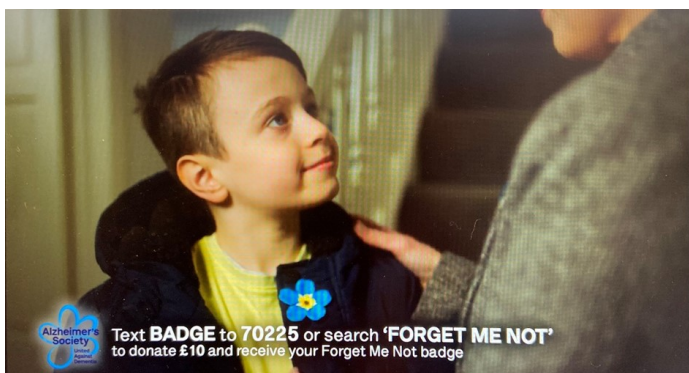
## What is dementia?
