In order to make the beginning and end of each school day as smooth an operation as possible, please follow our simple guidelines below. Please do not hesitate to chat to one of the SLT on the playground if you are unsure.

Please do not use your mobile phones on the school premises at any time. There are strict safeguarding guidelines that we need to adhere to.

Please do not allow your children (or adults!) to use the playground equipment.

Scooters and bikes are to be pushed through the playgrounds and not ridden.

Finally, we have a one-way system in place through the link corridor. Please observe this. Access is from the junior playground into the infant playground. Please do not go in the other direction. This avoids the frustrating queues that form when people travel in both directions.

If you need to access the junior playground, please use the Gordon Road gate.

If you need to access both playgrounds, please use the Gordon Road gate and exit Halifax Road.

If you need the Infant playground only, then please use either gate and exit via Halifax Road.
