






For those of you who drive your children to school, please

# **Comings and Goings**

I hope that the letters that I sent out earlier in the week regarding dropping and collecting children, particularly in relation to the 'one-way' area, helped to clarify any misunderstandings. We have erected some signs around the school entrances that should also help.

Please only enter the Halifax Road gates if you are intending to access the infant playground only. This is for classes RW, RG, 1A, 2NS, 2K only. If you need any of the other classes, please use the Gordon Road gate and pick up from the junior playground first. Once you have gone through the link corridor doors, please do not double back as this would be against the one way system.

When the link doors allowed 'two-way traffic', the chaos that often ensued generated many parental complaints as children often became detached from their parents in the large numbers of people all trying to get through the door at once!

The one-way system that we implemented as part of our COVD risk assessment demonstrated how efficient this was and meant that the unpleasantness around getting large numbers of people through a small doorway could be overcome.

We acknowledge that new rules can sometimes take some getting used to, but we do appreciate your patience and reassure you that the rule was implemented for safeguarding reasons, and to provide a more comfortable route through school at the beginning and end of each day..
