3. A certificate of Catholic Practice. To obtain this, please visit the Parish website www.catholoicenfield.org and follow their instructions.

Come and visit us? Please use the form on our website to book a school tour. The next tours are taking place on the week beginning Monday 21 November.

Whilst the Borough application is completed online, the two other forms should be submitted to the school together in person or via email to admin@st-georges.enfield.sch.uk Closing Date for Admissions: 15th January 2023.
