1. The application to the London Borough of Enfield (online).

2. The supplementary information form from our website. please download, complete and email to us. Please include in your email a copy of your child's baptismal certificate.

3. A certificate of Catholic Practice. To obtain this, please visit the Parish website www.catholoicenfield.org and follow their instructions.

Come and visit us? Please use the form on our website to book a school tour. The next tours are taking place on Tuesday 13 December.

Whilst the Borough application is completed online, the two other forms should be submitted to the school together in person or via email to admin@st-georges.enfield.sch.uk Closing Date for Admissions: 15th January 2023.

This has resulted in significant numbers of schools in the borough having surplus places, with many reducing the size of the school intake to lessen the financial impact of the lower numbers.
